All applications to the First Year Group 2025/2026 in Dunshaughlin Community College will only be accepted after the 7th October 2024 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 25th October 2024 @ 3pm.

Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications for the academic year 2025-2026 to Second, Third, TY, Fifth Year or Sixth Year Group in Dunshaughlin Community College will only be accepted after the 29th April 2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 23rd May 2025 @ 3pm. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy. Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply.

All applicants to the First-Year Group 2025/2026 will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	14th November 2024
Successful applicants to the First Year Group 2025/2026 must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Dunshaughlin Community College by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	29th November 2024 @ 3pm
Note: 1. Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above will result in the offer being withdrawn. 2. False & inaccurate information will invalidate the application.
